Rule Proposals to be voted on at Spring Meeting: 2017

1. Amend Rule

V1. Rodeo Payoffs and Finals Rodeo Qualifications #3 page 29

Add the verbiage to include novice members.

*To be eligible for year-end awards, and to be a contestant at the ICA finals, *both contesting cardholders and novice card holders* must be an ICA member in good standing, and have entered and competed in 6 ICA prime rodeos per event as an ICA member.

2. Amend Rule

Page 29, section VI Rodeo payoffs and Finals Rodeo Qualifications – A

8. If not enough contestants qualify (or enter) for the number of places to be paid in any event, the remaining places shall be divided evenly among those contestants who did qualify (have a score or a time).. IF NO ONE QUALIFIES for prize money in an event, the purse will be paid to the rodeo committee.

Rationale for Change:

All monies won will count for points towards finals. This will make the ICA consistent with other associations we co sanction with.

3. Amend Rule

Page 5 Novice Events

3. Entry fees for novice events will be \$20 in the purse. In addition novice entries will pay the other associated fees as in other events (Finals Fund, Judges Fee, Central entry fee, and committee charge). In the event that no one qualifies in a novice event, the \$20 per contestant purse will be paid to the ICA and go directly into the finals fund for that novice event. Any added money not paid out will go back to the committee. Winnings at the ICA finals will not count towards the Novice members \$500 maximum allowed winnings.
